Toboggans:

McCauley Mountain is a small ski hill in the Adirondack Mountains. We are not equipped to handle an additional 90 ski patrollers utilizing our equipment. To make certain each team has a toboggan to accomplish their objectives, we ask that every three patrollers bring a fully operational tuned toboggan, tail rope and carrier with them. The goal is 20 additional toboggans.

We will be utilizing the T-bar lift for the majority of the toboggan transport uphill, so please confirm your front crossover rope is in good order. We will provide a demo for those not familiar with T-bar loading. Please arrive early and transport the toboggans to the yurt next to the ski patrol building. We will have a sign in sheet to track toboggans. Yes, they will be safe there.

Fees:

There is a \$85.00 per person fee for those attending the Patroller School and Womens clinic. Please mail check to Jon Wilson, 218 Loomis Street, North Granby, CT 06060. There is a late fee penalty for those registering after January 27th. The charge is \$25.00

Lunch:

McCauley Mtn. Ski Patrol will have soups and sandwiches available to all patrollers for lunch. We would ask for a \$10 donation per person please. Breakfast options will be available at the hill in the morning. Coffee and water will be available through out the day at the yurt.

Jackets:
